Black-tailed prairie dogs now stand at one percent of their historic population. And they're disappearing fast. Remaining populations are becoming increasingly fragmented and isolated, hence more prone to disease and inbreeding.

Yet the onslaught continues. Shooters with high-powered rifles slaughter them for fun. Developers poison them or bury them alive with bulldozers. Even open space land is not safe, as managers kill prairie dogs to "preserve" rangeland for cattle.

To make matters worse, our unique prairie ecosystem depends on the prairie dog. As a keystone species of the Great Plains, prairie dogs support an abundance of animal life, including the ferruginous hawk, the black-footed ferret, and the swift fox. Wipe out the prairie dog and they'll all be gone.
